

Do you want to compete at state but didn't quite make it into the top 5?

Well here is your chance to still get to compete as a...

WILDCARD

To qualify as a WILDCARD:

You must have at least 24 overall total points state wide in either a Kata, Specialty, or Sparring division.

EXAMPLE:

Johnny had 12 points in the East Region in 10-11 Beg Kata but it doesn't put him in the top 5 for state.

He also went to a tournament in the Central Region and he ended up with 12 points in the 10-11 Beg Kata divisions there too but it doesn't put him in the top 5 there either.

However....if you add his 12 points from the East Region and the 12 points from the Central region it equals 24 overall points.

This would qualify Johnny as a WILDCARD in the 10-11 Beg Division.

- 1) It must equal at least 24 points....**
- 2) It must be in the same division no matter what region....**
- 3) You can qualify in Kata, Sparring and Specialty but you must have at least 24 points in each of those divisions or just one.**
- 4) Yes, you can have 6 points in one division in all 4 regions and still qualify.**
- 5) Wildcards will go in as a 6th place seed at State.**
